Gender Equality

- Artisan cooperatives for marginalized women ↑ incomes by 200% (UN Women).

From Gallery to Boardroom: Your 5-Step Art/SDG Integration Checklist



Help corporate sustainability teams leverage art partnerships to achieve their SDG commitments.

Step 1 Map Your SDG Priorities to Art Opportunities

- Action: List your top 3 SDG targets → Brainstorm art forms that could amplify them.
 - Example: SDG 5 (Gender Equality) → Partner with female artists for International Women's Day exhibits.
- Tool: Free SDG Compass (SDGcompass.org)

Step 2 Identify the Right Art Partners

- Options:
 - Local galleries (community impact)
 - Digital artists (for global teams)
 - NGOs like UNESCO (for heritage projects)
- *Red Flag:* Avoid "token" artist engagements—prioritize paid collaborations.

Step 3 Co-Create with Impact Metrics

- Sample KPIs:
 - Employee participation rates in art workshops
 - Media coverage sentiment analysis
 - Funds raised for SDG-linked causes via art auctions



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Step 4 Launch with Storytelling

- Pro Tip: Use art to visualize sustainability data (e.g., infographics by designers, sculptures from recycled materials).
- Example: Patagonia's "Art for the Anthropocene" campaign.

Step 5 Scale & Institutionalize

- Ideas:
- Annual artist residency programs
- "Art for SDGs" line item in CSR budgets
